Master's Committee Membership for any person who is not a UCSD faculty member (i.e. from other UC's, from non-UC institutions, non-professors...)	New rule as of 10/21: Non-UCSD faculty not OK as "1 of 3" members of a master's committee. However, they may be ok as 4th (extra) members of a master's committee, as below. <i>(Note: Profs from other UC's used to be OK as 1 of 3, but not under the new rules) :</i>	
	Grad Div Approval	A Professor from another UC can serve as a 4th member if the dept provides brief written justification in the comments section of the committee form. A CV could be provided in lieu of the written comments.
	Grad Div / Dean Approval	A Professor from a non-UC four-year university (with a verifiable prof title found on their website) can serve as a 4th member if the dept provides written justification in the comments section of the committee form. A CV could be provided in lieu of the written comments.
	Grad Div / Dean Approval	By exception, the following may be considered to serve as a 4th member of a master's committee. Request will require a letter with valid justification, CV, and Senior Assoc Dean Approval: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UCSD Research Scientist Series, <i>without</i> Lecturer appt • Post-doc from any institution • Professor from a community college • Non-university employee (ex. a scientist from a biotech co., TSRI, or NOAA)

	Grad Div Approval	A Professor from another UC can serve as a 5th member if the dept provides written justification in the comments section of the committee form. A CV could be provided in lieu of the written comments.
	Grad Div / Dean Approval	A Professor from a non-UC four-year university (with a verifiable prof title found on their website) can serve as a 5th member if the dept provides written justification in the comments section of the committee form. A CV could be provided in lieu of the written comments.
	Grad Div / Dean Approval	By exception, the following may be considered to serve as a 5th member of a doctoral committee. Request will require a letter with valid justification, CV, and Senior Assoc Dean Approval: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UCSD Research Scientist Series, <i>without</i> Lecturer appt • Post-doc from any institution • Professor from a community college • Non-university employee (ex. a scientist from a biotech co., TSRI, or NOAA)
