Subject: ACTION REQUIRED: Enroll in Direct Deposit Now

Dear Graduate Students,

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 situation **you should immediately sign-up for direct deposit for all university funds**, as we expect significant delays in receiving any type of paper check payments. For many graduate students this means you must register through TWO DIFFERENT direct deposit processes-- **1) employment/payroll and 2) stipends/financial aid**. If you are unsure which process pertains to you specifically, please register for both. If you're already enrolled in both direct deposit processes, no additional action is needed at this time.
